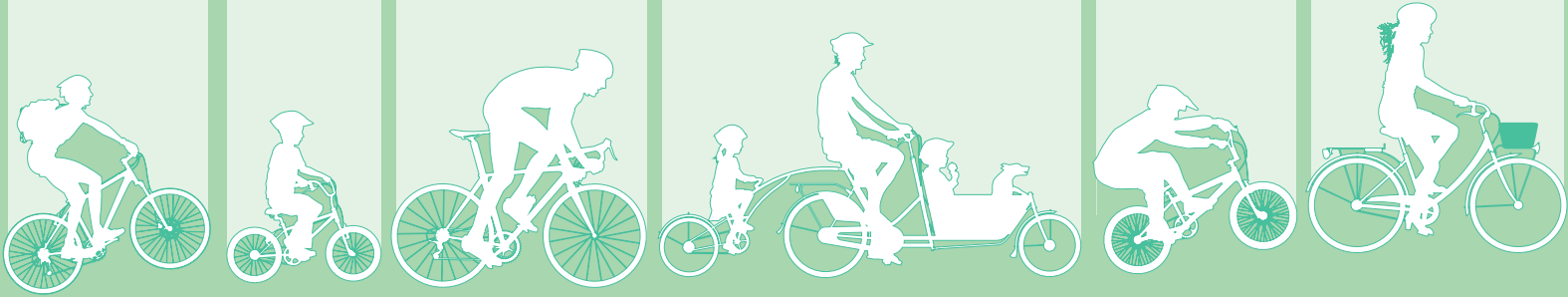


PEOPLE POWERED! DIY BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITIES
